The purpose of this letter is to determine the number of students who meet the medical exemption criteria listed below. This information will allow Perry Schools to plan for both On-Site and Off-Site (Remote) Learning starting January 4, 2020.

Perry Community School District started the 2020-2021 school year with 262 students taking Off-Site (Remote) Learning. The current number of Off-Site (Remote) Learning has reduced to 173 students. The district's goal for this year is to have all students taking classes On-Site. In Senate File 2310, it requires school districts to provide remote learning for the following cases:

Medical Exemption Criteria

If a parent or guardian notifies a district or nonpublic school in writing that a child, another resident of the child's residence, or one of the child's regular caretakers has a significant health condition that increases their risk of COVID-19, the district must make reasonable accommodations on a case-by-case basis to provide the child with the ability to attend school through remote learning. Notification must include:

- The name of the person with the significant health condition;
 - The health condition;
 - Written verification of the health condition from the person's physician or licensed health care provider; and
 - Whether the person- if other than the child- is a resident of the child's home or caretaker. Parents who want their child to continue Off-Site (Remote) Learning and meet the above mentioned criteria need to contact one of the following Perry Community School Staff Members:

No final decision has been made as to the learning platform set up or the length of school day. The purpose of this letter is to acquire data of the number of students who may need a medical exemption and take classes Off-Site (Remote).
